

Minutes for ICV meeting August 5th, 2009

Meeting called to order by president Lamolinara at 7:30pm

Previous minutes were not available but a synopsis of the last meeting was stated by president Lamolinara. No motion was taken since the July minutes were not read in full.

Treasurer report was read by Tim Jones, treasurer

Club presently has a balance of \$14,467.28 cents plus the \$5000 cd we have. Motion by Carl Fasshauer, second by Nelson Dahlstrom, motion carried

Old Business:

Mill Run Rodeo was discussed, they did not have a very large turnout but it was their first time for the event, the club made about \$150 and had about 7 people helping out.

Another weed eater was purchased and a hedge trimmer attachment was purchased to use with the machine.

The club put in about 3.5 miles of new trails on the new property.

Weed trimming continues on all existing trails and some trails were cleared and regrommed with the skid loader.

We now have about 27-28 miles of trails total.

New business:

We discussed the new trail from the event parking field to the existing trails, this will now be the permanent way to get

to the trails, no one should be going straight up the hill from the little parking area to the trails, If you park in the little parking area the way to the trails will be across to the event parking area then up the hill and follow the signs.

Signs have been erected to show you the way.

The club approved a bid of \$5500 for the erection of a road into and out of the event parking area, also pipe and a drainage system to be put into place to control some of the water runoff. Finished off with stone placed on the roads in and out and covering the pipe that is going to be placed into the ground for drainage.

Discussion about the Picnic on August 9th, club to provide Chicken, corn water and cool aid drinks. Everyone who attends was asked to bring something to share with the group. Plan on eating at noon, riding will start at 9:30am with guided tours of the new trails for those who want to see where they are.

There will also be a work party to put up the tents and do some trail clearing .trimming Saturday August 8th starting at 9:30am.

The club will be attending the Blue Knob poker run ride in Portage RT 164 exit off of RT 22, club members who want to meet will gather at 8:30am at the Ebensburg McDonalds on RT 22.

The club also voted to attend the Scottdale parade on Sept 19th.starts at noon, if interested meet at Allen Geska's house

at 11am, Allen's number if you want to go is 724-887-9711, call if you need directions.

The club also talked about the guest policy, no non members should be riding on the property without signing a waiver and paying someone, either a member or an officer the fee of \$10 per rider. And wear a helmet. If you see someone riding without a tag stop them and ask if they are a member or did they pay for the day, if not then ask them to leave the property.

Bob Breakiron mentioned about the twp with our help placing posts and fence around an old cemetery that was located while we were putting in new trails on the new property. The twp will supply the posts and the fence if we supply the manpower to put the posts in and put up the fence. Bob will check on cost of renting a gas powered post hole digger to see if this will ease the installation.

The 50/50 raffle was won by Nelson Dahlstrom \$13.50 and was donated back to the club.
